Episode #148 Ruth Seeks Refuge

Going Deeper

(Some ideas to help you use the *S.O.A.P. Method of Study)

1. **Vs 11:** Boaz knows they are related but doesn't give it away to Ruth. The Author keeps her in suspense. Has God ever kept "The Whole Picture" from you at anytime? What did you learn during this situation?

2. Vs. 12: Boaz blesses Ruth. Commentator Matthew Henry considers this a "strong gesture of affection to a stranger in the land." The Hebrews were also instructed by God to treat strangers kindly. How is God using you to show kindness or bless someone you met in the grocery store or at work this week?

3. Where do you find your refuge? Read and journal through Psalm 91:1-8

4. There is always room at God's Table for those who love Him. Read Revelation 19:6-10, the scene at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb for those that are redeemed by the blood of the Lamb. Those that have put their trust in, take refuge in, surrender their hearts to, bow down to in obedience, surrender their life to, are washed clean of their sins by the blood of Jesus that He shed on the cross for our sakes, will be invited to sit in the Heavens at the table with Jesus. Take some time to consider the scene, and write out a prayer of thanks to God. For one day we will bow down before our strong tower, our Refuge, who extends us grace and invites us to dine with Him and live with Him for eternity.
